

Atopy (also referred to as atopic or allergic dermatitis) is a long-term condition caused by sensitivity to allergens in the environment, such as dust mites, pollen or mold spores.1,2

Atopy starts deep under the skin – in your pet's immune system. Immune cells react to an allergen which cause itch and other uncomfortable symptoms.²

What are typical symptoms?


You're likely familiar with the most common symptom: itch.2 But, atopy includes a number of other symptoms, including:2,3

- Red, thickened skin
- Hair loss
- Inflammation (swelling)
- Secondary skin lesions or infections

ATOPICA goes beyond the itch - for more complete control.


It gets to work at the source of the problem
