



*Roundworms (*Toxocara cati*) and tapeworms (*Echinococcus multilocularis*), in particular, can infect humans as well as pets. Human infection with hookworms (*Ancylostoma tubaeforme*), though rare in Canada, is also possible²⁻⁴.

Regular deworming is important to keep your cat healthy

Any cat—even indoor cats—can become infected with worms, but they may not show signs of infection. These parasites are harmful to your cat’s health, and severe infections can be fatal. In addition, certain roundworms (*Toxocara cati*) and tapeworms (*Echinococcus multilocularis*) can pose a risk to the health of your family.

Feline expert groups recommend deworming up to four times a year. (CPEP, Cat Healthy)³⁻⁵

Indications

Milbemax is indicated for the prevention of heartworm disease caused by *Dirofilaria immitis*, and for the treatment and control of parasitic infections due to the adult stage of hookworms (*Ancylostoma tubaeforme*), roundworms (*Toxocara cati*) and tapeworms (*Dipylidium caninum*, *Taenia taeniaeformis*, and *Echinococcus multilocularis*) in cats six weeks of age or greater and/or weighing greater than 0.5 kg body weight.
