Arthritis and your cat

Cats often hide signs of pain and suffer in silence

Arthritis is a condition that leads to pain and progressive degeneration of the joints¹. It affects many aspects of a cat's life including limiting mobility, causing sore joints and ultimately a poor quality of life. Signs can often be subtle and you may never notice lameness in your cat. It is important to look out for other signs like a change in behaviour. This may include defecating outside the litter box, hesitating when jumping and/or difficulty grooming. Cats in discomfort may also elect to sleep in areas of the house that do not require stairs to minimize movement.

Arthritis is common in cats of all sizes, ages and breeds so it is important to monitor your cats' behaviour from a young age. Did you know that up to 40% of all cats have arthritis with it happening to any breed at any age²?

What is Solensia[®] and how does it work?

Solensia is an innovative therapy called a Monoclonal Antibody. It targets and neutralizes nerve growth factor (NGF), a protein that stimulates pain in cats with arthritis.

Through this action, Solensia helps alleviate pain for a full month without many of the side effects associated with other medications.

How is Solensia given?

Solensia is administered by a member of your veterinary team as a monthly injection.



How long is Solensia given for?

If your veterinarian has prescribed Solensia, it means that your cat has been diagnosed with arthritis and is in pain. Arthritis is a life-long disease which may progress over time. Fortunately, it can be effectively managed with the help of Solensia. It is therefore important

to maintain your cat's monthly visits to ensure he/she remains comfortable, and maintains a good quality of life.

More than one monthly injection may be needed before reaching the desired treatment level. Your veterinary team may also recommend a change in diet, supplements or home environmental modifications.
